**B2068 STONE STREET, MONKS HORTON**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2018**

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2068 Stone Street, Monks Horton, near Folkestone.

Overnight closures are planned from Tuesday 12 June 2018 for two nights, from 19:30 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

B2068 Stone Street will be closed between the junctions with Pilgrims Way and Farthing Common.

*~ There will be no direct access to Canterbury from A20 / M20 / Hythe direction using the B2068 during these works ~*

The alternative route is via B2068 Stone Street, Stamford Bypass, A20 Stanford Interchange, A20 Ashford Road, Sandling Road, Broad Street, Station Road, Canterbury Road, New Road, High Street, Canterbury Road, Elham Valley Road, Derringstone Hill, Valley Road, Black Robin Lane, Bonny Bush Hill, Bridge Hill, High Street, A2050 Dover Road, Old Dover Road, B2068 Nackington Road, Faussett Hill, Street End and Stone Street.

Local access to the remainder of B2068 Stone Street continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.
