A20 SANDLING ROAD, POSTLING

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2018

To allow major cable installation works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A20 Sandling Road, Postling, near Folkestone.

A closure is planned from Monday 9 July 2018 for an estimated period of up to 6 weeks.

A20 Sandling Road will be closed between A20 Ashford Road, Sandling and A20 Ashford Road, Saltwood (i.e. between the turnings for Saltwood and Lyminge)

The alternative route suitable for all traffic is via A20 Ashford Road, Stanford Intersection, Ashford Road, A261 Hythe Road, London Road, A259 Military Road (Dymchurch Road and Scanlons Bridge in opposite direction), Red Lion Square, Rampart Road, Prospect Road, East Street, Seabrook Road, Sandgate Esplanade, Sandgate High Street, Sandgate Hill, Sandgate Road, Earls Avenue, Castle Hill Avenue, A2034 / B2064 Cheriton Road, A20 Cheriton Interchange, and Ashford Road.

Access to the remainder of the A20 continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed. Access to Sandling Road, Sandling (i.e. to Saltwood) is from a western direction, and access to Sandling Road, Sandling (i.e. to Lyminge) is from an eastern direction.

During overnight closures of B2068 Stanford Bypass, currently planned from 19 July for 5 weekday nights, A20 Sandling Road will be re-opened at nights to avoid a diversion clash.

Other than this, the road will need to remain closed outside the working hours.
